

Roulette

Instantly recognisable as *the* classic casino game, American Roulette is largely a game of pure chance.

The buzz and excitement which surrounds a busy table in full flow is one of any casino's main attractions. From casual players to "high rollers", Roulette offers every client an equal chance of winning and is usually first on our clients' wish list.

Using casino quality equipment, our tables can comfortably accommodate 12 or more players. A maximum of 10 players will be allocated a particular chip colour which they may buy and cash in for the numbered "money chips". This avoids confusion when paying winning bets to players. All other players must play with numbered "cash" chips until a colour becomes available. Each player will then place any number and variety of bets whilst awaiting the rattle and drop of the ball. The croupier will clear away the losing bets, pay the winners and then spin again.

How to bet at a Roulette table

There are numerous ways of betting on roulette which include high and low risk strategies. Where you place your chip or chips on the layout determines the odds of your bet. Quite simply, the more numbers your chip covers the lesser the odds. By covering a single number (known as a "straight up"), a winning chip will be paid at odds of 35-1. By covering all red numbers or all odd numbers, for example, the winning bet would be paid at even money. The full list of odds is as follows:

Chips covering

1 number - 35-1

2 numbers - 17 -1

3 numbers - 11-1

4 numbers - 8-1

6 Numbers 5-1

Dozens - 2-1

Columns - 2-1

Red/ Black Even Money *

High/ Low - Even money*

Odd/ Even - Even money*

*For even money bets, the player will lose half their stake should the number "0" come in.

Your croupier will assist in placing bets and will be more than willing to help with any questions the players might have. There are also printed guides for playing roulette available at the table.
